## DETAILED ITINERARY:

---

### DAY 1: ARUSHA

On arrival at the Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be met by our representatives who will transfer you to the African Tulip Hotel for check in and your overnight stay. Booking is on (BB) bed and breakfast basis.

Arusha, the gateway to the world famous game sanctuaries of Serengeti, Ngorongoro, Tarangire and Lake Manyara, is one of the oldest towns in Tanzania. From a tiny German garrison in 1900, Arusha has grown to become the tourist capital of Tanzania with a population of about 400,000 people. At 1,540 metres above sea level, Arusha enjoys a very agreeable climate throughout the year. Positioned at the centre of Africa between the Cape and Cairo on the Great North Road, Arusha is the administrative seat of the East African Community made up of Tanzania, Kenya and Uganda.

Arusha offers an excellent opportunity for authentic souvenirs shopping, including the bold Makonde carvings, and the colourful Tinga Tinga works and batiks.

Tanzanite, the native gemstone of Arusha, and one of the most beautiful and exciting gems to come from Africa, is sold in all gemstone shops in town alongside other locally mined stones like Ruby, Rhodolite and Tourmaline. Tanzanite was first discovered in 1967, some 40 kilometers to the southeast of Arusha at Mererani. To date Mererani remains the only commercially viable source for Tanzanite in the world. Tanzanite was named after Tanzania.

### DAY 2: ARUSHA – TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, you depart for Tarangire National Park. Arrive in time for check in and lunch at the Tarangire Sopa Lodge. After lunch relax for a short while and later go for an afternoon game drive.



Tarangire is a park of giant baobab trees, rolling savannah and acacia parkland. Home of the rare tree-climbing pythons, this park offers the best accommodation during the dry season. Due to the existence of the Tarangire River, thousands of animals make their way to this park in search of water. It is in this 2,850 sq. Km park that you are very likely to encounter Lions, Leopards, Zebras, Buffaloes, Wildebeest among others. And just like many parks in Tanzania, this one also has an abundant array of 550 or more species of birds setting the stage to an incredible bird watching experience.

**Meal Plan: Full Board**



### DAY 3: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK – NGORONGORO NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast depart for Ngorongoro Conservation Area where you will have lunch at your lodge. The lodge sits on the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater from where you get awesome views of the collapsed volcano.



After a short rest break, proceed for an afternoon tour of the crater. This area's main attraction is the Ngorongoro Crater, fondly known as "Africa's Garden of Eden". A candidate for the new seven wonders of the world, this massive crater holds its own in that category. Being the world's largest unbroken caldera, Ngorongoro is home to over 25,000 animals. It is considered one of the best game viewing spots in the world with a chance to see the big five, zebras and wildebeests. The crater holds almost every individual species of wildlife in East Africa including the extremely rare and critically endangered Black Rhino.

### DAY 4: NGORONGORO NATIONAL CONSERVATION AREA - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After your breakfast you will depart with picnic lunch boxes for the Serengeti National Park, arriving in time for your afternoon game drive enroute to the Serengeti Serena Lodge/ Serengeti Sopa Lodge/ Serengeti Kati Kati Camp. You will then spend the evening at leisure.



Serengeti is the stage on which the most spectacular wonder of nature takes place, the Great Migration. It is on this park that millions of ungulates comprising of wildebeests and zebras make that all important trek from the Serengeti to the Masai Mara National Park in Kenya. But that's not all the Serengeti has to offer, it boasts the largest and highest concentration of wildlife in the world. Spanning an impressive 15,000 sq km area, this savannah is

home to all the members of the Big 5, the splendid cheetah, gazelles, African wild dog, giraffes and approximately 500 species of bird, making it a bird watchers' paradise as well.

**Overnight: Serengeti Sopa Lodge**

**Meal Plan: Full Board**

#### **DAY 5&6: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK**

You will spend the whole day in the Serengeti National park with both the morning and evening game drive. An alternative would be to go for a whole day's game drive with picnic lunch boxes and return to your lodge later in the evening.

**Overnight: Serengeti Sopa Lodge**

**Meal Plan: Full Board**

#### **DAY 7: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK – LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK**

After your breakfast, 0630 hrs- depart for an early morning game drive in the Serengeti. After breakfast, drive at 1000 hrs to the Ngorongoro Highlands. You will have lunch at Gibbs Farm, formerly a working coffee farm. Then proceed for an afternoon visit of the waterfalls en-route to Lake Manyara to arrive in time for dinner at your lodge.

**Overnight: Lake Manyara Serena Lodge**

**Meal Plan: Full Board**

#### **DAY 8: LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK – ARUSHA - ZANZIBAR**

After breakfast, depart at 0830 hrs for a morning game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. Famous for its breathtaking show of flamingos, this park also host to the very rare tree-climbing lions. This is the only other location in the world where you can encounter these elusive lions. Add the over 400 species of birds, Big Five, blue monkeys, dik-dik, gazelle, hippo, giraffe, impala among others and this 330 sq. km park is a game lover and birdwatchers' paradise.



Return to the lodge for lunch. 1400 hrs- Drive back to Arusha. Later in the evening drop off at Kilimanjaro International Airport for your flight to Zanzibar, where another of our representative will transfer you to the Ocean Paradise Beach Resort for check in and overnight stay.

**Overnight: Ocean Paradise Beach Resort**

**Meal Plan: Half Board**

**Day 9-12: ZANZIBAR.**

You will spend the whole day leisurely at your beach hotel with optional water sport activities and Zanzibar excursions available at extra costs.



Zanzibar Island, whose local name is Unguja, is one of two main islands that make up the semi-autonomous state of Zanzibar. It is a partner state in the United Republic of Tanzania, the largest country in the east coast of Africa. Zanzibar is located in the Indian Ocean, about 35 km off the coast of mainland Tanzania, at Longitude 39 degrees East and Latitude 6 degrees south of the Equator. The highest point of the island is 150 meters above sea level.

The Island's capital, also known as Zanzibar, is one of the oldest cities in Africa and boasts of a World Heritage Site in its collection of some of Africa's most valuable ancient architecture. It was established and for centuries ruled by Omani Sultans who reigned supreme in the east coast of Africa before the Portuguese and later the British came calling.

**Overnight: Ocean Paradise Beach Resort**

**Meal Plan: Half Board**

**Day 13: DEPART.**

After your breakfast, depending on your departure flight, you will spend the morning at leisure before being transferred to the Zanzibar Airport in time for your flight back home.
